Reducing risk: Recent change to condominium insurance regulations could benefit Alberta owners

New changes to the *Alberta Condominium Property Act* bring forward good news for both individual condominium owners and the corporations themselves.

The legislation change addresses *how* the corporations' insurance deductible can be charged back to the at-fault unit owner in the event of damages. This lowers the financial burden felt by the individual unit owners *and* the condominium corporation.
