Alberta Allows Temporary Relief with Remote Witnessing of Wills and Estate Planning Documents

Alberta will temporarily allow for remote witnessing of Wills, Enduring Powers of Attorney, and Personal Directives where one of the witnesses is a lawyer in good standing with the Law Society of Alberta.

This good news took effect on May 15, 2020 as Alberta's Minister of Justice and Solicitor General, Doug Schweitzer issued a Ministerial Order allowing for temporary relief under the authority given to him under the *Public Health Act*.
