Revised Condominium Regulations Come into Force in Alberta

November 27, 2019

On November 27, 2019, the Government of Alberta [announced](#) the release of its revised Regulations and amendments to the *Alberta Condominium Property Act* that will come into force January 1, 2020.

These adjustments are the result of the Government's five-month review to ensure that Regulations do not cause unnecessary administrative burden or challenge for condominium corporations, owners and industry professionals.
